Subject: Changes to End-of-Life Schedule for Verifone Ruby and Gilbarco G-SITE

Dear ExxonMobil Distributor/Dealer:

This letter is to inform you of an update to the ExxonMobil's Point of Sale Systems (POS) Strategy and implementation plans we provided to you in June 2005. This update is based on Retailer feedback and the POS supplier's plans for supporting specific POS systems. The NBIF recently reviewed this update and are supportive of the changes we are making. It addresses your requests for additional time to prepare for and implement these changes.

- *Verifone Ruby and Gilbarco G-SITE end-of-life dates will be extended one year.*

All other POS end-of-life dates remain the same. We encourage you to equip all new, rebuilt or upgraded sites with a POS configuration that is identified below as a go forward platform.
